<u>Flower & Vegetable Show – Young Persons' Section</u> <u>Shawford Parish Hall on August 31st 2019.</u> Once again we hope that lots of young people will enter the classes specially for them and get their friends to enter as well.

There are a few simple rules for the Young Persons' Section and I've listed them here:

- Entry forms must be returned to me at the above address or to Jan Brook at 18 Grove Road, Southdown (tel: 714030) by Thursday 29th August together with 25p for each class entered.
- All exhibits must be your own work and you can only make one entry in each class.
- Bring your exhibit to the Parish Hall between 9 a.m. and 10 a.m. for judging between 10.30 a.m. and 12 noon. You can come to the show in the afternoon between 2.30pm and 3.30pm. At 3.30 the prizes and certificates will be presented and you should take your exhibits away immediately after that.
- For all classes in SECTION F, the AGE of the exhibitor, at the date of the Show, must be clearly stated in the right hand class box.

Certificates and points will be awarded in each class to 1st (5), 2nd (3), 3rd (2) and highly commended (1) plus one point for each entry. The judges' decisions are final.

There will be a Young Persons' Trophy for the person who gains the most points overall in the Young Persons' Section Classes F1 to F8 and a Trophy for the Best Exhibit in the whole of the Young Persons' Section
