Local Updates

- Bridleway linking Shawford Down and Southdown Rd –out for consultation until 3rd September.
- Shepherd's Down School (19/01154/HCS) application for a temporary classroom approved with associated conditions to allow 20 more pupils whilst a permanent solution is considered.
- HCC's Safety Engineering team is reviewing the causes and frequency of reported incidents on the Otterbourne Rd with Hampshire Constabulary following the recent collision.
