## Responding to the Bushfield Comp Planning Application

An outline planning application has been submitted to Winchester City Council for an employment-led scheme on the Bushfield Camp by the Church Commissioners for England.

The deadline to comment, object to or support the application has been extended until 7th December. You can comment online (details below).

We will also be holding a workshop to help you comment on Saturday 25th November from 11am -2pm at Badger Farm Community Centre.

The outline planning application doesn't give much detail apart from access to and from the site and to develop around 96,500m2 (excluding car parking) for research and development, academic uses and academic accommodation, a hotel, and other complementary/ancillary uses including a nursery, retail including shops, restaurants, cafes, bars, visitor and exhibition space, leisure and sports uses. Many national and local planning policies are used to decide whether an application is granted. We have listed some of the important policies from the Winchester District Local Plan.

You may wish to comment on how the development may be contrary to any of these using your own words.
